

## Forced Choice-Paired Comparison Activity

On Monday, May 10, 2010 the School Board participated in activity related to the eight building configuration options identified in the recent feasibility study. This activity was used to support the Board's discussion of its options. The activity requires each person to choose between two options at a time (a forced choice between pairs). The results provide a profile of the overall Board's thinking at that time, as we organized the total responses in this activity and discussed the group of options that we first want to examine more closely. No options are yet "off the table" for the Board's consideration, and the discussions may include options beyond those identified in the study.
