Title I Parent Involvement Policy

Parent involvement is an integral part of the Title I Program in the Indiana Area School District. The administration and staff recognize the significance of a partnership between home and school to help children realize their fullest potential.

1. Parents will receive informational letter notifying them of their child's eligibility for Title I.
2. Back to School Night is scheduled early in the school year to provide an overview for parents of participating children.
3. Parents are encouraged to visit their child's classroom to observe during American Education Week or other designated time.
4. Parents are encouraged to become involved in their child's school through the Title I Parent Advisory Group and the PTA.
5. Parents are encouraged to attend Parent/Teacher conferences. Conference days will coincide with the district calendar. Specific information about skills and strategies will be provided, as needed, by the Title I staff.
6. Timely information will be shared via telephone call, letter, e-mail, and the IASD school website.
7. An activities letter will be mailed to parents of elementary students twice a year describing class activities.
8. Parent meeting – There will be at least one Title I parent meeting per year in addition to the Title I overview on Back to School Night.
